FACILITY HAPPENINGS

The Canteen has been set up for your safety with social distancing, taking your temperature on arrival and offering a facemask if you do not have your own which are required by all. A reminder, the only authorized times to be without a facemask on is if you are sitting at a table, drinking or eating, whenever you get up to move around for any reason you are required to have your facemask on.

Wooden nickels are now being accepted in the canteen until 30 November 2020 at which time they will no longer be accepted. A new method is being developed by the Board of Directors to compensate volunteers for their service, more information to follow at a later date.

Chicken Wings are back on a trial basis for Saturday nights on 5 September 2020 and again on 12 September 2020. The wing teams will be composed of employees who will do all the preparing in the kitchen and then serve the wings, there will be individuals walking around the canteen to take your orders.

Breakfast is back. Starting Saturday 19 September 2020 for a 2 day trial we will be serving a limited menu breakfast from 0900 - 1200. Social distancing is still required and the table settings will be limited to 4 per table.

For Members only, we will be celebrating Labor Day in the canteen with hamburgers, hotdogs and such on 7 September 2020 from 1200 hours until 1500 hours. There will be a ticket menu that you check off what you want and turn it into the bartender, once the food is ready it will be brought to your table. The meal is free.

Reminder on guests, you are authorized to bring any number of guests into the canteen that you want but if the building capacity is reached guests will be asked to leave to make room for a member. Also, all guests must be signed into the facility and issued a band to wear on their wrist while in the building. The member is responsible for their guest.

Salutations from the MOC and MOCA! Good things are in the works as we keep driving our way through the Pandemic era and some fun stuff is on the way to help us support our mission to support our veterans!

The visitation restriction policies at McGuire VA Hospital are still in affect... but we aren't going to let that stop us from helping our veterans there out! Both groups will be donating money to purchase these items, but donations from anyone are always welcome. We are also planning on doing another video to send down to McGuire for Veterans Day... everyone down there thoroughly enjoyed the one we sent them for Memorial Day!

We are beginning a Veterans Pen Pal program based off some information that was sent to us from the Help Heal Veterans organization. If anyone is interested in getting involved with that, please shoot me an email! We have also reached out to some of the local food banks that support homeless veterans and are awaiting responses from them. I envision that we can do things for them like a food drive at the post to donate supplies to the food banks, Cooties volunteering time at the food banks... more to follow as things develop on this front.

Several events and fun stuff are in the works at the post including a cornhole tournament tentatively scheduled for 17 Oct, a horseshoe tournament in the newly refurbished horseshoe pits next to the Pavilion is currently being discussed... info will be provided as plans solidify. Our usual flea markets are in a bit of a limbo state given pandemic related concerns by people that usually set up tables to sell things and the people that usually go to flea markets to browse and purchase things. As always, take care of yourself, your families, your friends, and your fellow veterans in this pandemic era. All the best to everyone in these trying times!
