Restoring the Use of VA Disability Benefits Questionnaires (DBQs)

In March 2020, despite strong objections from the VFW and other service organizations, VA removed public facing Disability Benefits Questionnaires (DBQs) from the VA.gov website. Since their removal, the VFW has advocated for these forms to be restored as DBQs allow veterans the ability to submit medical information in support of their claim in a standardized format. We are pleased to inform you that VA has officially restored the public facing Disability Benefits Questionnaires (DBQs) on VA.gov.

To access and use these DBQs, visit

https://www.benefits.va.gov/compensation/dbq_publicdbqs.asp and download the specific form that is needed for your claim. Do not use previous versions of DBQs that you may have already saved to your computer. Please note, these DBQs should be completed by the veteran's health care provider, and all DBQs must be properly completed with the provider's credentials prior to submission to VA.

CANDIDATE FOR JUNIOR VICE COMMANDER


